



Call for Candidates for the EuPA Young Investigator Prize (PhD)

EuPA-YIP. The European Proteomics Association (www.eupa.org) hereby announces a call for candidates for the EuPA Young Investigator Prize to be awarded at the Annual Congress EuPA Congress from March 24 – 28, 2019, in Potsdam, Germany (<https://www.eupa2019.org>). A special session on Tuesday, March 26, will be dedicated to presentations, which will be given by the finalists selected from the submitted abstracts. The winner, judged by the panel after the presentations, will receive €1.000, sponsored by the Journal of Proteomics from *ELSEVIER*, and a EuPA certificate. The winner of the Young Investigator Prize will also be announced in the major proteomics journals.

Eligibility. To qualify, candidates have started or obtained their PhD or MD degree not later than three years before the time of submission and must be a member of a EuPA affiliated society and working in a European laboratory. Candidates can apply directly during the online-registration of the conference. The national society should have paid their membership fee for 2018 to the European Proteomics Society.

Submission. EuPA-YIP candidates should **register for Annual EuPA Congress/PROTEOMIC FORUM2019, submit an abstract and must present their material personally at Proteomic Forum 2019.** Abstracts submission is now open at www.eupa2019.org.-In addition, the abstract, a **short CV and** two letters of support of senior scientists should be submitted to the EuPA secretary (Dr. Viviana Greco, viviana.greco@unicatt.it) and to eupa@conventus.de no later than the **15th of January 2019.**

EuPA-YIP finalists will be selected to hold a presentation and will be notified prior to the conference. Those not selected as YIP finalists will be further treated as normal conference registrants.
